Tips for "Thinking About the Procedures" with Davis's Nursing Skills Videos

"Thinking About the Procedures" are questions that go hand in hand with the **Davis's Nursing Skills Videos for RN**. (The Nursing Skills Videos are also posted as a free resource on the <u>Distance Learning Hub</u> <u>for Undergraduate Nursing</u>.) They are a great tool to assess students' clinical reasoning skills and provide additional practice to ensure safe patient care when performing key nursing procedures.

Davis's Nursing Skills Videos do follow the written step-by-step procedures presented in the *Fundamentals* of Nursing and Basic Nursing textbooks. However, the answers to the "Thinking About the Procedures" questions are not found in the textbooks. Students must watch the associated video from the Davis's Nursing Skills Video collection for the answers.

TIP Assign the "Thinking About the Procedures" questions for a participation or completion grade to help track 'attendance' and ensure students are keeping up from home. The questions are in Word doc format so students can email you their responses as proof of completion. The Instructor version of the questions includes the answers.

TIP Use your Learning Management System's (LMS) Discussion Board to foster online discussions. Post the "Thinking About the Procedures" questions to your LMS. Ask students to watch the associated video from the Davis's Nursing Skills Video collection and then go to the Discussion Board to answer the questions. You can also hide the responses so students cannot view other students' answers until they have posted their own responses.
