Ranked #3 in the Midsize Companies' category Special Award for Work/Life Flexibility

For the third year in a row, <u>F.A. Davis</u> has been recognized as one of the **Top Workplaces** by *The Philadelphia Inquirer*, the region's most prominent newspaper and news website. The company placed third in its first year in the Midsize Companies' category and was also recognized with a Special Award for Work/Life Flexibility. These awards celebrate the organizations that prioritize a people-centered culture and give employees a voice that enables them to meet today's ever-evolving technological, social, and economic challenges.

Of the 4,917 companies in the region invited to participate, 171 companies were selected based only on employee feedback gathered by *The Inquirer's* research partner Energage, LLC, a leading provider of technology-based employee engagement tools. Employees completed an anonymous survey in December 2022 that measured essential facets of workplace culture, including company leadership, career opportunities, workplace flexibility, compensation, benefits, and the impact company policies have on innovation and morale. Companies were grouped into three categories, small, mid-sized, and large. F.A. Davis was counted among the top 52 midsize companies with 150-499 employees.

"This honor is a recognition of all our employees do to make us a little bit better every day and to live our values of communication, teamwork, customer service, and the ability to adapt to change in everything we do," said Robert H.
